Maritime and logistics - the backbone of global trade

- Maritime and logistics industries facilitate the movement of approximately 80% of worldwide goods (UNCTAD)
- Maritime and logistics activities contribute to about 2.8% of global greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions (IMO)
- Without additional policy action, shipping's greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions are expected to grow 16% from 2018 to 2030 and 50% by 2050 (ICCT)
- Global maritime trade expanded by 2.4% in 2023, with projections indicating an average annual growth rate of 2.4% through 2029 (UNCTAD)
- New vessel deliveries totalled approximately 1 million TEUs by the end of 2024 (Hillebrand Gori)
- As of October 2024, shipping companies have placed orders for 522 dual-fuel vessels capable of operating on both conventional fuels and cleaner alternatives (Reuters)

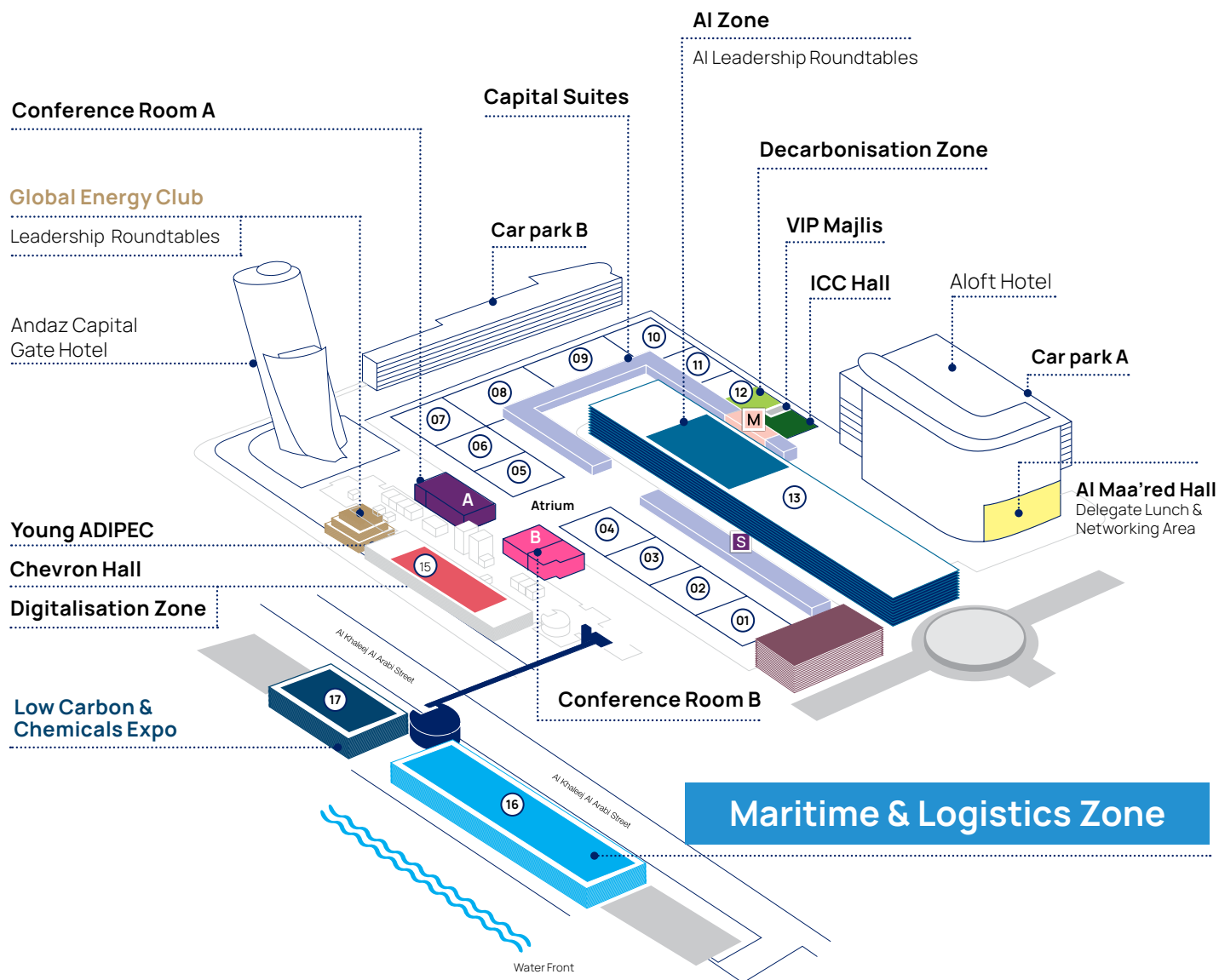
ADIPEC VENUE MAP
